Washington, DC – March 1, 2013 – Kevin J. Connolly, AIA was selected for the National Building Information Standards – US (NBIMS-US) vision task force by NBIMS-US chair Chris Moor. His role will be to help define a long term vision for NBIMS-US and create a roadmap that will guide future development of the standard.

“Without a long term strategy and clearly defined goals and objectives, we are in danger of having organizational, schedule and content changes at every version of NBIMS-US”, said Moor. “Clearly this is not in the best interests of adoption of the standard. To avoid or limit this, this workgroup is tasked with developing a long term vision for NBIMS-US.”

Connolly joins an elite group of visionaries from many parts of the capital facility industry. Results will be unveiled at the 2014 Building Smart Alliance conference in January.
